

Guidelines for CRC Surveillance 2012

Baseline colonoscopy: most advanced finding(s)	Recommended surveillance interval (y)
No polyps	10
Small (<10 mm) hyperplastic polyps in rectum or sigmoid	10
1–2 small (<10 mm) tubular adenomas	5–10
3–10 tubular adenomas	3
>10 adenomas	<3
One or more tubular adenomas \geq 10 mm	3
One or more villous adenomas	3
Adenoma with HGD	3
Serrated lesions	
Sessile serrated polyp(s) <10 mm with no dysplasia	5
Sessile serrated polyp(s) \geq 10 mm	3
OR	
Sessile serrated polyp with dysplasia	
OR	
Traditional serrated adenoma	
Serrated polyposis syndrome ^a	1

^aBased on the World Health Organization definition of serrated polyposis syndrome, with one of the following criteria: (1) at least 5 serrated polyps proximal to sigmoid, with 2 or more \geq 10 mm; (2) any serrated polyps proximal to sigmoid with family history of serrated polyposis syndrome; and (3) >20 serrated polyps of any size throughout the colon.
